POWER OUTAGES

ENTRANCE /EXIT GATES

SPEEDING

SPEED LIMIT IS 5 MPH

CARDBOARD BOXES

FLATTEN ALL BOXES

Cardboard boxes rule is simple, FLATTEN THE BOX AND THROW INSIDE THE BIN unless it is full. Then place between the fence and the bin. No trash or other materials is allowed



ENTRANCE WALK-IN GATE (PEDESTRIAN)

The walk-in Gate next to the Entrance Gate will be locked starting June 1st. For those needing access to enter, you will require a card key to open the walk-in gate. We urge all unit owners to apply for the card key. First card is free of charge (\$5 from second card).
